DSEK ADVANCED CORNEA COURSE

This two-day course features Descemet's Stripping Endothelial Keratoplasty (DSEK). Corneal specialist Francis W. Price, Jr., M.D. presents lectures and slides, supervises wet labs, conducts postoperative examinations and performs live surgeries. There is a strong emphasis in the course on technique and avoidance of complications.

We are now accepting registrations through 2008 (please see attached Registration Form for dates).

LOCATION: Price Vision Group, Laser Eye Center, Suite 101, 9002 North Meridian Street, Indianapolis, IN 46260.

DRESS: Business casual. Ties and jackets are not necessary. Scrubs will be provided for the live surgeries. Please refrain from wearing perfumes and colognes.

TAXI: Taxi rates from the airport to Price Vision Group and our preferred hotel, Homewood Suites, generally are about \$50 one-way. However, if you call in advance, you may reserve a taxi with Carmel Circle City Cab at a rate of \$35 one-way (317-848-5757). A private sedan is available from Capital City Coach for \$60 one-way (317-484-8484).

ACCOMMODATIONS: *Homewood Suites by Hilton.* Price Vision Group has a special room rate of \$92 per night for a King or Twin Master Suite at the Homewood Suites by Hilton located at 2501 E. 86th Street, Indianapolis, IN 46240, about three miles from Price Vision Group. A complimentary breakfast buffet and evening hors d'oeuvres are included in the rate. All rooms are suites with separate bedroom and living room, and a kitchen.

Shuttle Service: Homewood Suites provides a shuttle to Price Vision Group. Please confirm your need for the shuttle when you check in. The shuttle is available to locations within five miles of Homewood Suites (not to the airport).

DIRECTIONS: Travel time: 30-45 minutes from the airport, depending upon traffic.
To Price Vision Group: From the Indianapolis International Airport (IND), take 465 N then 465 E to the Meridian Street Exit / US 31 South. Proceed a half mile south on Meridian and turn west onto 91st Street. Price Vision Group is located in the Lakeview Office Park on the SW corner of 91st and Meridian. Enter the west parking lot off 91st street.
To Homewood Suites: From the Indianapolis International Airport (IND), take 465 N then 465 E to Exit 33 (Keystone Avenue). South on Keystone Avenue and exit onto 86th Street (Nora/Castleton). West onto 86th Street. Homewood Suites by Hilton is on the left after Haverstick Road.

DSEK Advanced Cornea Course

REQUIRED MATERIALS:

Participating physicians must bring the following items:

- 0.5 and 0.12 forceps (participants have reported bringing these items in their carry-on luggage without difficulty.)
- 3 or 4 human corneal scleral rims at least 15 mm in diameter.
- Two whole globes to practice inserting the donor tissue. If you would like to spend extra time in the wet lab on day two, please bring extra whole globes.

There is no good equivalent for human eyes on which to practice the dissection and donor insertion. Fresh eyes always are preferable.

There are two wet labs: day-one for all physicians. Day-two (during the live surgeries) for physicians who would like to watch a several of the surgeries and also have a little extra time in the wet lab. The day-two wet lab time is abbreviated. If you would like extra time in the wet lab on day-two, please bring extra practice tissue or save some of your practice tissue on day-one.

You may bring your practice tissue with you or have your eye bank ship it to us.
